# Defence exams

- **Air Force Common Aptitude Exam (AFCAT Exam)**

# UPSC Combined Defence Services Exam (CDS)

# The methodology

- Study whatever you are taught in the school curriculum seriously.
- Have a good look at the **Exam syllabus** & understand about the nature and trends. of the examination.
- Once you have gained a good idea of the exam syllabus and scope, you should start preparing at your own speed.
- Do not rush through the topics. Since there are still 3+ years for you to be eligible for the exam, you must internalize whatever you read.
- Do not jump directly to the high-level books. Rather, focus on the **NCERT** first, and then move gradually to the other **study material**.
